Dear Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application dated 17.6.2000 and subsequent correspondence with the school/ inspection in this regard, I am directed to convey the sanction for Provisional/Composite Provisional Affiliation for Secondary School Examination of the Board w.e.f. 1.4.2000 to 31.3.2003 with the **permission to accept the list of 19 candidates of class X who are to appear at Board's Exam. 2001**. The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of the following conditions :

1. The school will follow the national syllabus for the middle classes.
2. The school will follow syllabi and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Secondary School Examination and changes made therein from time to time.
3. The school shall appoint only qualified and eligible staff.
4. The school will help the Board in the smooth conduct of the examination by providing the necessary accommodation i.e. Halls, Rooms available in the school premises and furniture at its disposal for holding its examinations free of charge, if required.
5. The school will spare sufficient teachers for invigilation purpose at the examinations of the Board, as may be required.
6. The school will spare its teachers for evaluation of answer-books for the Board's examinations, if required.
7. The school will provide Laboratories, Library and other facilities as per norms of the Board.
8. The school will abide by the conditions of affiliation already prescribed or may be prescribed by the Board from time to time.
9. Service agreement be executed with the staff as per norms generally accepted by the State Government concerned.
10. Service conditions, pay and allowances and other benefits to the employees of the school shall be in no way less than that of corresponding employees working in Government schools of the State in which the school is located. An undertaking to this effect be sent to C.B.S.E.

Notes

11. The school and its records shall be opened for inspection by an official of the Board or an authorised representative of the Board/State Education Department at any time and the school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time.
12. The rate of tuition fee and other fees charged should be commensurate with the facilities provided.
13. The admission to the school shall be opened to all without any discrimination on the ground of religion, cast or race, place of birth or any of them.
14. No unrecognised classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the same name of school.
15. The school will not sponsor candidates for Board's examination of any other School/Branch which is not affiliated.
16. The school will create Reserve Fund as per the requirement of the Affiliation Bye-Laws/Rules of the Directorate of Education, Delhi in the joint names
17. The school should not start class XI/XII without written approval of the Board. The Board shall not be responsible for any consequences in case class XI/XII is started without following the affiliation bye-laws and obtaining the prior approval of the Board.
18. The affiliation Code Number allotted to your school is **5830**..... This may please be noted and quoted for any correspondence with the Board. Original Receipt No..... dated..... for Rs..... is also sent herewith for office record.
19. Annual fee @ Rs. 1000/- per annum for the year(s) **2000-2003**..... be also remitted at an early date. (In case of overseas Independent school @ Rs. 5000/- p.a. and overseas Kendriya Vidyalayas @ Rs. 3500/- p.a.)
20. The school will apply for further extension of Provisional Affiliation on the prescribed form together with the prescribed fee and other essential documents in the preceding year before the expiry of the date.

21. The school managing committee should be constituted ^{Yours faithfully,} per CBSE norms and a list of 5-6 members of nearby KV/JNV schools affiliated to CBSE not below the rank of Principal be sent so that two of them may be approved by the Board. **(DARSHAN LAL)**

Other Conditions :

Conditions for which compliance to be submitted within three months of issue of sanction letter:—

1. Running/Starting of Class IX/X & XI/XII without prior Provisional Affiliation upto Secondary level/Sr. Secondary level from the Board would be unauthorised classes and school shall be responsible for the consequences arising out of it.
2. School will not prepare any student/start any class for any other Board except CBSE from their CBSE affiliated school building/premises.
3. The Board would not allow any transfer of property/sale of school by one society/Management/Trust to another Society/Management/Trust through agreement/sale deed and the school shall not be closed down in the same premises. In case such transaction is effected explicitly or implicitly, the Board shall withdraw its affiliation with immediate effect.
4. Pay & Allowances to staff should be revised time to time to bring it at par with that to State Government.
5. The service conditions be strictly followed as per State Education Act and staff be given appointment/confirmation letters etc. accordingly.
6. 5-6 names of persons not below the rank of Principal of Sr. Secondary School affiliated with the Board be recommended so that two of them may be approved by the Board as its nominee in the School Managing Committee.
7. The school shall maintain section teacher ratio at least 1:1.5 at each level i.e. Primary (I-V) Secondary (VI-X) and Sr. Secondary (XI-XII).
8. Rs. ~~30,000~~ on account of annual fee for the three years may please be remitted.
9. The school shall maintain Reserve fund in the joint names of the Manager of the school concerned and the Chairman of the Board in the scheduled Bank to the extent indicated below:—

Upto -500	Students	Rs. 60,000/-
501 -750	„	Rs. 80,000/-
751 -1000	„	Rs. 1,00,000/-
above-1000	„	Rs. 100/- per student rounded to nearest thousand.

The interest accruing out of the deposit of reserve fund made by the Institution at the time of affiliation/extension of affiliation be not withdrawn by the management under any circumstances what so ever.

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:-

1. The approval is based upon the documents /data/information uploaded by the school online. The school will be responsible for its genuineness. In case of any discrepancies, necessary action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow all the provisions of Affiliation Bye-Laws- 2018, Examination Bye-Laws, circulars, guidelines, instructions and other amendments issued from time to time by the Board.
3. The School shall possess following valid mandatory documents at all times :
 - a. No Objection Certificate
 - b. Recognition Certificate
 - c. Land Certificate
 - d. Fire Safety Certificate
 - e. Building Safety Certificate
 - f. Certificate of Registration of Society/Trust/Company
 - g. Safe Drinking Water and Sanitary Condition Certificate
4. The School shall also ensure the compliances with the Board's Bye-laws in respect of following facilities and infrastructure within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS portal.

1. Boundary Wall: Concrete boundary wall of not less than 6 ft. height, enclosing the school campus/site. Composite boundary walls which are partly concrete and partly grill/mesh/barbed wire below 6 feet will not be acceptable. If fencing/grill is required, then the same should be over and above 6 feet height.
2. Ramps at the entrance(s) as well as Ramps/lifts for CWSN, to access the upper floors of the school (in case of a multistoried school) (Circular No. CBSE/AFF-05/2023 dated 06.03.2023).
3. Separate toilets for CWSN, boys and girls on every floor (in case of multistoried schools) (Circular No. CBSE/AFF-05/2023 dated 06.03.2023).
4. Appropriate laboratory infrastructure for Secondary School (Composite Science Lab, Mathematics Lab, Computer Lab) and for Senior Secondary School (Composite Science Lab, Mathematics Lab, Computer Lab, Physics Lab, Chemistry Lab, Biology Lab.) (Circular no. CBSE/AFF-11/2022 dated 04.10.2022)
5. Well stocked library with adequate reading area. (Circular no. CBSE/AFF-11/2022 dated 04.10.2022)
6. Well-developed indoor and outdoor sports facilities. (Circular no. CBSE/AFF-11/2022 dated 04.10.2022)
7. Well-developed Digital Infrastructure (Circular No. CBSE/AFF-10/2023 dated 24.03.2023)

Failure to comply within the prescribed time may invite financial penalty @ 50,000/- per month until compliance is submitted and may debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students' class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

If the compliance is not submitted with in the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.

Note :-

1. The School is required to apply online for extension of affiliation before its expiry along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.

3.
